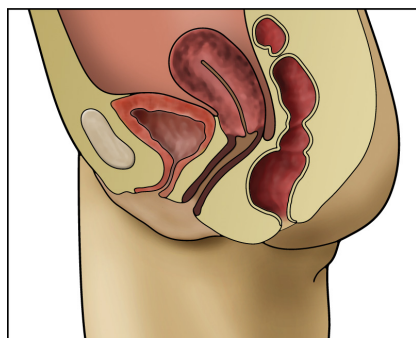


Description

Obstetric trauma is a major cause of faecal incontinence in women, and anal endosonography is an established gold standard in the diagnosis of sphincter defects. Abdul Sultan and Raneer Thakar are consultant urogynaecologists who are internationally renowned as experts in obstetric trauma and work closely with colorectal surgeons. They currently run international hands-on workshops on perineal and anal sphincter trauma (www.perineum.net).

This workshop aims to provide skills in all aspects of pelvic floor and anal endosonography that would interest the novice as well as the more experienced. The faculty comprises of international experts Professor Pawel Wieczorek, Radiologist, Lublin, Poland and Professor Giulio Santoro, Consultant Colorectal Surgeon, Treviso, Italy.

The programme will be comprehensive, encompassing a global perspective to pelvic floor trauma and includes levator injuries, rectoceles, cystoceles, obstructed defaecation, urinary and anal incontinence.
